Scuola Grande di San Rocco -Venice

The Scuola Granded iSan Rocco,a historic confraternity building in Venice, renowned for its extraordinary cycle of paintings by Tintoretto, considered one of the masterpieces of the Venetian Renaissance.



Sant'Andrea della Valle -Rome

Sant'Andrea dellaValle, a magnificent Baroque basilica in Rome, famous for its grand dome—one of the largest in thecity—and its richly decorated interior with frescoes by leading 17th-century artists.



Santo Stefano al Ponte -Florence

Santo Stefano al Ponteis a deconsecrated historic church in Florence near the Ponte Vecchio, dating back to the Romanesque period and today used as a cultural and exhibition space, reflecting centuries of the city's religious and artistic heritage.


Park Hotel Villa Fiorita -Treviso
